generative AI /'dʒenərətɪv eɪ aɪ/ n. 生成式人工智能

生成式 AI 是一类通过学习大量训练数据中的模式、结构和规律，从而能够生成全新内容的机器学习模型。

【例句】Generative AI can produce text, images, and music based on simple prompts. 生成式 AI 能够根据简单的提示词生成文字、图像和音乐。

【例句】Many companies are racing to integrate generative AI into their products. 许多公司正在竞相将生成式 AI 融入他们的产品中。
